The Toulouse goose is not a good sitter, and it is best to set her eggs under a large, heavy hen.

There are many other beautiful and curious breeds of geese, of which the beautiful:

**CANADA GOOSE**

This is not uncommon on the ornamental waters of our English parks.

**THE SEBASTOPOL GOOSE**

This is really a sort of White Frizzled Goose, the plumage being not only turned back like Frizzled Fowls, but very silky and soft in texture.

**THE CHINESE GOOSE**

Of two principal colours:

1. The Brown, with dark brown or black bill and brown eyes, and a darker brown stripe down the neck and back, and dark orange shanks.
2. The White, with orange bill, deep blue eyes, and orange shanks. The *Book of Poultry* says the White Chinese should also have a brown band down the back, but the American Standard says the plumage should be pure white. They have a large brown or black knot at base of bill.
