Salim Ali was as active in the field of conservation as he was in ornithology. He was probably the only person who had travelled to all the obscure regions of the Indian Subcontinent at one time or another of his life and knew the country, its forests and its birdlife intimately. He lived and worked for the birds of his land, to present these ethereal spirits of the air to his countrymen and to the world.

This updated text with currently recognized scientific and common names, and useful new indexes is an invaluable field companion for birdwatchers.
